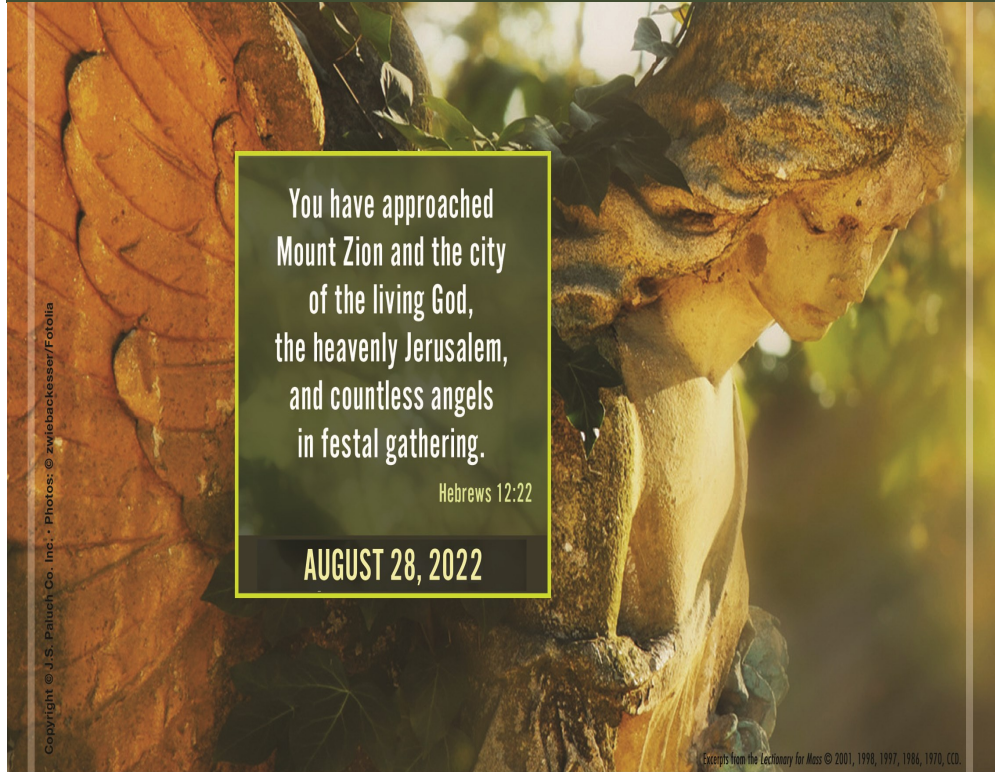

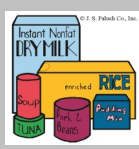
Motherhood Ministry

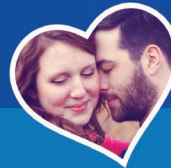

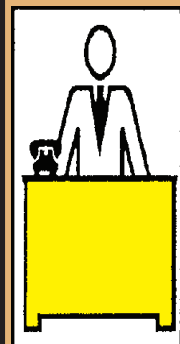
