#### **Rotary International** is looking for host families for the Rotary Youth Exchange

A local student from JHS has been accepted as an exchange student for the 2022-2023 academic year. For her to participate, Rotary is looking for host families in Jonesboro, preferably those with kids in the JPS system.

**GOAL**: Find three to four host families

TIMEFRAME: August 2022 through May 2023 (with three families, the student would stay with each family for about 3 months)

AGE/GRADE: 15-18 in 10th to 11th grade (likely female)

<u>COUNTRY</u>: Most likely from Italy but possibly France or Japan

HOST FAMILY RESPONSIBILITIES: The student will be provided \$100/month stipend from Rotary. The host family would be responsible for anything beyond that, such as food, board (private room w/a desk or shared room with another child of same gender), transportation to/from school and other activities. The hope is the family would treat the exchange student as one of their own.

<u>LEGAL</u>: A background check & home visit is required.


