A local student from JHS has been accepted as an exchange student for the 2022-2023 academic year. For her to participate, Rotary is looking for host families in Jonesboro, preferably those with kids in the JPS system.

- GOAL: Find three to four host families
- TIMEFRAME: August 2022 through May 2023 (with three families, the student would stay with each family for about 3 months)
- <u>AGE/GRADE</u>: 15-18 in 10th to 11th grade (likely female)
- <u>COUNTRY</u>: Most likely from Italy but possibly France or Japan
- HOST FAMILY RESPONSIBILITIES: The student will be provided \$100/month stipend from Rotary. The host family would be responsible for anything beyond that, such as food, board (private room w/a desk or shared room with another child of same gender), transportation to/from school and other activities. The hope is the family would treat the exchange student as one of their own. LEGAL: A background check & home visit is required.
