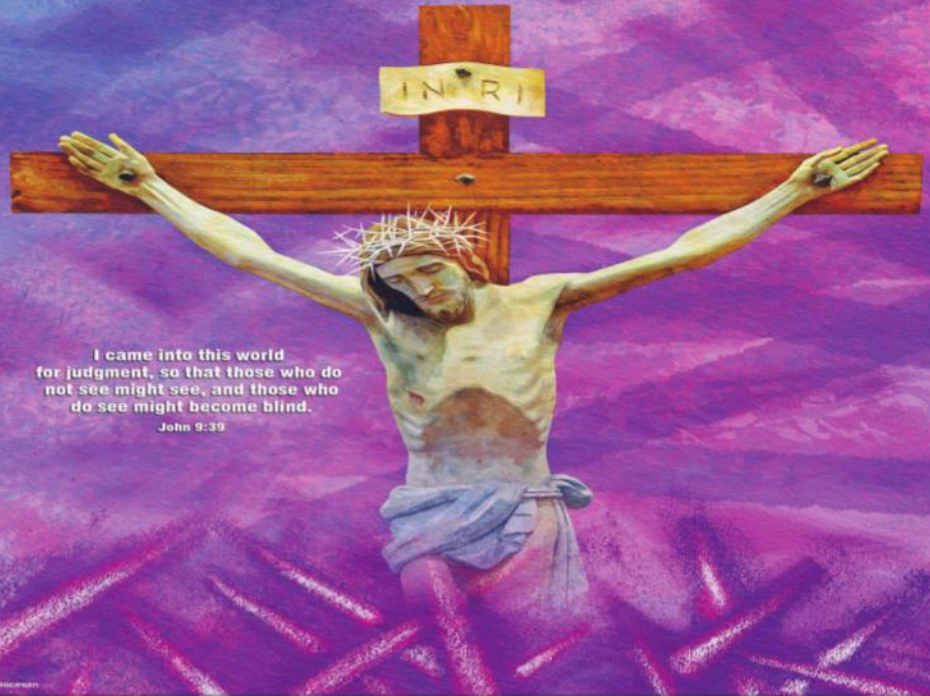


**MARRIAGE GUIDELINES**
